Dear families,

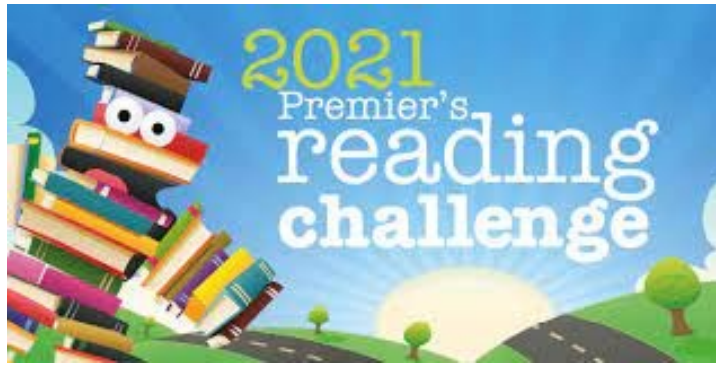

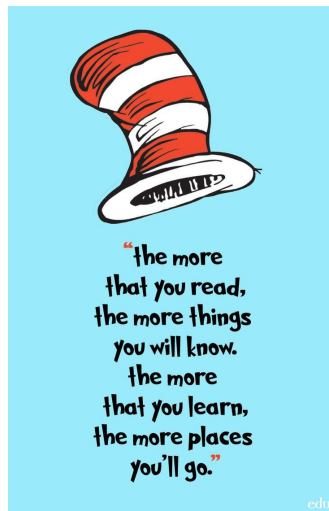
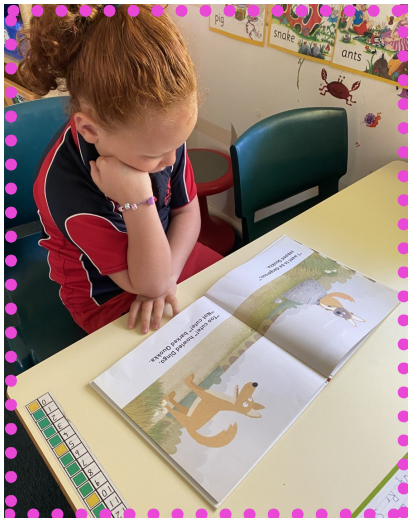


### Premier's Reading Challenge 2021

It is a pleasure to congratulate all our students on completing the challenge this year.

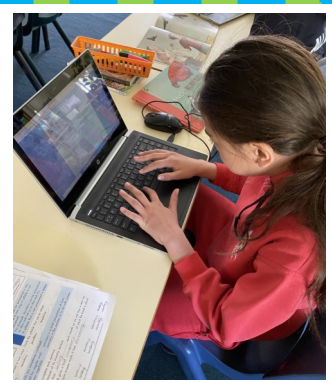
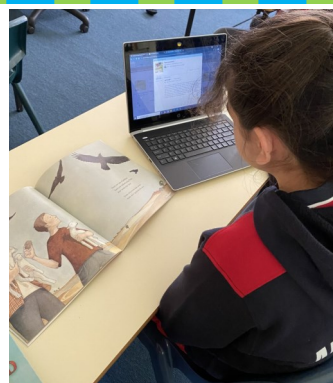


### Oliver Library
